

Quad Kids competition 20/6/17

On Tuesday 20th June, 16 children from Key Stage 2 took part in the Quad Kids competition at Woodham Academy.

Quad Kids is an Athletics competition where every child takes part in 4 events. Year 3&4 competed in a 50m sprint, 400m run, standing long jump and a mini-vortex howler throw. Year 5&6 competed in a 75m sprint, 600m run, standing long jump and a mini-vortex howler throw.

When not taking part in these 4 events, there were 4 activities set up to take part in: skipping relay, island hopping, bean bag relay and bean bag throw. Each child took part in every event and would try to earn points for their team in the 4 main activities.

All children tried their best and worked well as a team cheering each other on. In the year 5/6 boys' competition Devin finished 3rd with 148 points and Alyssa finished 3rd with 143 points in the girls' competition. Olivia finished joint 2nd in the year 3/4 girls' competition with 127 points. Overall, our year 3/4 team finished second with 904 points.
