Sports Funding 2017 - 2018

Our funding allocation for 2017/18 will be around **£17000** thanks to the recently announced top up fund from the DfE to add to the usual allocation of Sports Premium.

Aims:

This year, we will want to maintain the Gold Level Sainsbury's School Games Mark. We are aiming to increase the after school club attendance beyond 89%. The MUGA is now fully operational and we are intending on having most PE lessons and after school sports clubs to take place there.

We are aiming for all children to be able to take part in at least 30 minutes activity and are developing provision to give a wider range of options for our pupils to take part in during lunchtimes and break times. To enhance this we are going to further demarcate our outside space into clear zones with investment intended for a new floor trim trail, running areas, football & netball opportunities and two stages with a sound system (including an itunes account) for children to dance and perform upon. Also improved access to the new garden area will give further opportunities for the children to be active (£4800).

Last year we had 10 children trained to act as leap leaders last and we hope to double that this year. This will help promote physical activity throughout the school during break and dinner times. We hope to get our sports leaders to complete a nationally recognised certificate in sport leadership. We also have arranged for our Year 4 children to take part in a 2-day outward-bound session, in April 2018.

We also plan to get a member of staff trained in Forest Schools to get better use of our wooded area (£1200).

Through our continued involvement in the **SSP** we will be receiving coaching and support for gymnastics, multi-skills, OAA, as well as striking and fielding and invasion games (see below).
